Councilwoman Kane requested that the entire report be read aloud in an effort for a full open discussion. Carla Cefalo read the Zoning Recommendation report compiled by the HBP Economic Development Committee, titled Highlands, Yesterday, Today & Tomorrow. HBP also provided one copy of a bound book of approx 100 pertinent photos.

Mayor Nolan was pleased with the professionalism of the report and the amount of time spent compiling the data. Carla read an email into the record from HBP member, Christian Lee. The email was taken into consideration and HBP will address Council via written request for Stymies property for parking. Also discussed from the email was the fact that HBP omitted an important fact that the current uses in the PB zone obviously don't work anymore. The board should recommend rezoning the PB zone to the B-2 overlay zone, while also allowing single family residences since there are several of those in the PB zone as well, so that we can have more uses permitted and develop this important gateway into and out of our town into a flourishing business area.

Since changes had to be made to the report, we agreed to vote electronically.
